

# 2025 Global Korea Scholarship (Graduate Program)

## Program Objective

The Korean Government Scholarship Program is designed to provide higher education in Korea for international students with the aim of promoting international exchange in education, as well as mutual friendship amongst the participating countries.

## **Eligibility**

- The applicant and his/her parents must have foreign citizenships. And all applicants must hold citizenship of NIIED designated countries that are invited to take part in the GKS program.
   \* Applicants who hold Korean citizenship are not permitted to apply for this program.
- 2. Applicants must be under 40 years of age as of Sep. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025 (born after Sep. 1<sup>st</sup>, 1985).
- Current academic professors in one of the Official Development Assistance (ODA) recipients\*
   who are under 45 years of age (born after September 1, 1980) are eligible to apply.

- **3.** Applicants must hold a Bachelor's (For Master's program) or Master's degree (For the Doctoral program) or a diploma that is equivalent by July 31st, 2025.
- 4. Applicants who have completed a degree in Korea are not eligible to apply.
- **5.** Applicants must hold a grade point average (G.P.A.) of at least 2.64 on a 4.0 scale, 2.80 on a 4. 3 scale, 2.91 on a 4.5 scale, or grades/marks/score of 80% or higher from the previously attended institution.

### Selection Procedure

<u>**1**<sup>st</sup> Selection</u>: Each 1<sup>st</sup> selection institution (Korean Embassies or designated universities) will select and recommend the best applicants according to its respective standards.

<u>**2**<sup>nd</sup> Selection</u>: The NIIED Selection Committee will select the most successful candidates from the pool of applicants recommended by the 1<sup>st</sup> selection institutions. Applicants who were recommended by a designated university will automatically be granted admission to the university that recommended them, upon the condition they are selected as a successful candidate in the  $2^{nd}$  Selection.

<u>**3**<sup>rd</sup> Selection</u>: Only the candidates who were recommended by a Korean embassy and passed the  $2^{nd}$  selection successfully will be evaluated for admission by the 3 universities to which they applied; each candidate has to gain admission from at least one university.

## Scholarship

#### 1. Duration of Scholarship:

> Master's (01.09.2025 ~ 31.08.2028): 1 yr. of Korean language + 2 yrs. of Master program

- Doctoral (01.09.2025 ~ 31.08.2029): 1 yr. of Korean language + 3 yrs. of Doctoral program \* NOTE!
  - After the Korean language course, the scholarship period of degree course cannot be extended beyond the designated duration.
  - In the case that a scholar possesses a TOPIK Level 5 or 6, he or she must be exempted from the Korean language course and must start his/her academic course of Master or Doctoral.

All documents including transcript, self-introduction, study plan, certificate of language proficiency (Korean and English), recommendations, published papers and awards, etc., will be evaluated

### Required Documents

1. Required Documents: One original document (Copied documents are not accepted)

2. Documents not in English or Korean must be accompanied by a complete English or Korean translation authenticated by the issuing institution or notarized by a notary's office.

### Important Notes

- Dual applications are not accepted. Applicants must apply for this program via only one institution.
- Documents should be presented in their original form.
- Submitted documents will not be returned to the applicants.
- Incomplete or incorrect documents may lead to application rejection or failure in the Selection Committee, and scholarship revocation even after entry into Korea.
- In case of submitting photocopied documents, applicants MUST have the copies notarized or apostilled and then submit the notarized or apostilled copies.
- Applicants must accurately complete the health checklist truthfully. All successful candidates must take a comprehensive medical exam before orientation. The candidates who are judged to be physically unfit for this program will not be accepted.
- Transferring to a different university and different department after confirming the host university is not permitted under any circumstance.

## Accommodation

- 1. Priority to enter on-campus residence halls are given to GKS scholars and the university supports 50% of dormitory maintenance fee.
- 2. Facilities in the residence halls: internet zone, study room, praying room, laundry room, fitness

center, table tennis courts, multi-purpose outdoor playground for soccer and basketball, etc.
